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# VOICES ISRAEL GROUP OF POETS IN ENGLISH LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Poets,

First, best wishes to all for a happy and kosher Passover! For many of us the past few weeks have seen a flurry of activity as we spring-clean and prepare for the seder. To the joy of all of us in Israel, the Covid restrictions were relaxed, enabling us to enjoy the festival with our extended families. We sincerely hope that life will soon get back to something at least approaching normal for our overseas members too.

In early March we had a very successful Zoom workshop, led by Elana Dorfman, on poetry inspired by the senses – chiefly the sense of smell. 24 of us attended, of whom an unprecedented 22 filled in the online evaluation form created by our Membership Coordinator, Yochanan. The feedback was overwhelmingly positive, especially regarding Elana's conduct of the workshop, and we hope we'll have the pleasure of more workshops from her in the future. We'll be producing an e-chapbook from this event, for distribution to the attendees.

We had a happy increase of membership renewals ahead of the end of the Early Bird rate. The Early Bird period is now over, but if you didn't manage to renew during it, you can still do so at the standard rate – easiest via PayPal from our website.

The submission period for the Anthology closed in mid-March. The editors have been hard at work making final decisions, and everyone should by now have received a notice regarding each poem submitted. I understand from Dina, our Chief Editor, that over 300 poems were submitted and just over a third were accepted. Thanks to the changes made to the whole process the year before last, we are to date running well ahead of our usual schedule for producing the Anthology.

Looking ahead: on April 5<sup>th</sup>, right after Pesach, we'll be holding the AGM. Linda has sent out the financial reports together with the official notice about it. Please remember to register with Susan Olsburgh to get the Zoom link if you would like to attend; and if anyone has not yet registered for the Open Mike and would like to participate, please send me **now**, by email (to <u>president@voicesisrael.com</u>), the titles of one or at most two poems you would like to read at it. It does seem that we'll have time for two poems each.

Looking further ahead: we've fixed the date of the Bar Sagi and Reuben Rose joint awards ceremony for Sunday May 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7:30 pm (Israel time). We're hoping that since it's a Sunday, members from outside Israel will find it easier to attend, since evening hours in Israel are morning to midday hours in the US. The full details are in the announcement of it in this newsletter.

We are still trying to organize the Netanya "Poetry by the Sea" residential workshop for late May or early June. Enough of our members have said they'd come, but the hotel only starts taking bookings from May 18<sup>th</sup>, which gives us very little time to get a price quote and receive firm commitments. So right now, unfortunately, the workshop's fate is still undecided.
