

#### LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Poets,

We have had an invigorating past month! Though forced to finally cancel the two-day residential workshop, we refused to give up: we converted it into two one-day workshops, in Netanya on June 7<sup>th</sup> and in Haifa on June 23<sup>rd</sup>. Both were fully signed-up, though unhappily the Haifa workshop had a few last-minute cancellations due to illness. We were all happy to get back to "real" face-to-face meetings. Thank you to all our presenters – Eli Ben-Joseph, Luiza Carol, Elana Dorfman, Iris Dan, and Dina Yehuda who so flexibly accommodated themselves to the last-minute changes of plan.

The feedback on the Netanya workshop was very valuable, especially the comments. One or two people noted that "auditorium type" seating works better than seating around a long table for noise control and easy hearing of presenters; a couple also requested that we send out the handouts in advance, to give people time to read the example poems. I suspect this is something we got used to in the Zoom era and are now loathe to give up! We'll certainly keep both comments in mind for future workshops and look forward to getting the feedback on the Haifa workshop too.

We're returning to the practice of printing chapbooks from workshops, since we're back to holding them as "real" meetings. The Netanya workshop chapbook is in preparation while our Haifa participants are still in the grace period of polishing their rough drafts.

Going forward: our **50**<sup>th</sup> **anniversary event** is coming up - *registration is open for both the event and the Open Mike at the end of it.* It will be a really fun event – do join us! Wendy Blumfield has been working hard with our long-term members to collect their memories and sample early poems, and Chaim Bezalel is helping us to produce a chapbook of the event. Many thanks to both! We intend to print it so that we have a permanent souvenir, and distribute it to all of you together with the anthology. Again, the program of this event has been sent to you all and is also in this newsletter.

Reminder: Linda our secretary is stepping down next March, and we're looking for someone to replace her. We're also considering splitting her role and having a separate Newsletter editor. If you're interested in either role, please contact me at the above email address. Voices Israel's success depends on the willingness of us all to volunteer and "give back" a little.

Finally, the 2021 Anthology is ready for the printer; we'll print it and the chapbook from the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary event together and distribute them both to all our paid-up members, hopefully ahead of the Chagim.
