LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Poets,

Shavuot has come and gone, but Corona is unhappily still with us, as we enter the summer vacation period. But we're learning to live with it: the next event we're currently planning is the launch of the 2022 Voices Israel anthology, probably in October after the High Holidays (no date set yet), and we aim to hold it as an in-person event.

Meanwhile the chapbook from the Netanya Residential workshop is just being finished – the last people have sent in corrections if any from their proofread, and I've sent it to the printer. Copies should be available in a couple of weeks. Anyone who has not yet ordered a copy and would like one (or more), please do email me with the number of copies and the address to mail them to. The price, as estimated, will be 20 NIS plus postage.

The Anthology is also well underway – it's been compiled and is with Dina for her initial proof-reading. Many thanks to Avril Meallem, who wasn't able to produce it this year but did such a good job last year that, using her template, the compilation was very quick and smooth. The next stage, after Dina's proofread, will be to send it out to all the poets who have poems in it, for each of you to proofread your own poems. The aim is to do that sometime in the first half of July.

JANE MEDVED is the author of Deep Calls To Deep (winner of the Many Voices Project, New Rivers Press) and the chapbook Olam, Shana, Nefesh (Finishing Line Press) Recent essays and poems have appeared in Ruminate, The North American Review, The Cider Press Review, The Normal School, and The Seneca Review. Her awards include winner of the 2021 RHINO translation prize and Honorable Mention - 2021 Janet B. McCabe Poetry Prize. Her translations of Hebrew poetry can be seen in Hayden's Ferry Review, RHINO, Cajibi and Copper Nickel. She is the poetry editor of the Ilanot Review, and a visiting lecturer in the Graduate Creative Writing Program at Bar Ilan University, Tel Aviv.

YEHOSHUA NOVEMBER is the author of the poetry collections God's Optimism (a finalist for the Los Angeles Times Book Prize and winner of the MSR Book Award) and Two Worlds Exist (a finalist for the National Jewish Book Award and Paterson Poetry Prize). His work has been featured in The New York Times Magazine, Harvard Divinity Bulletin, The Sun, VQR, and on National Public Radio and On Being's Poetry Unbound series.

Submission is free; they pay 3¢/word, minimum \$5, maximum \$25 for accepted work. Deadline for both the competition and for regular submissions is July 19.
